**Campers:** Camp Triumph for Young Children is a specialized summer day program for boys and girls ages 4-6. While our campers are very diverse, some of them have challenges with emotion and behavior regulation, social communication, play skills, and flexible thinking. The group sizes for camp are 4-6 children with 2 counselors. A licensed psychologist supervises the staff.

**Program Description:** At Camp Triumph, young children experience success with peers because they are coached in developmentally appropriate social skills and pragmatic language. In addition, structured interventions and curricula are utilized to promote self-regulation skill development and expected social behaviors. With opportunities to develop skills in a safe, structured environment, children with identified special needs will more likely have a healthy social adjustment across school and peer environments. To help children generalize skills learned, we collaborate with parents throughout the camp process.
