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What We Offer

Therapeutic Summer Camp: Camp Triumph is a therapeutic day camp in North Reading that caters to children and adolescents (ages 6-16). With highly skilled counselors and structured therapeutic programming, the camp's goal is to build social skills, self-regulation skills, and self-esteem through recreational activities.

Social Skills Groups: In Reading and Lexington, we offer social skills groups for children, adolescents, and young adults to enhance their social and emotional development.
