The cost for Triumph Transitions is \$2,950 per 3 week period. Transitions participants can apply for one or both periods. Individual weeks are not available. We are closed on July 4th.

How to Apply

All new applicants or any who have not participated in a Triumph program within the last year must complete an intake interview. There is a non-refundable interview fee of \$150.

The primary purpose of the interview is to determine the young adult's individual needs, confirm program suitability, and discuss leisure, social, and vocational goals.
